  - V. **Presentation** – Erick Lobao, GIS Project Manager will present on the City of Columbus's Home Again Initiative which is designed to stabilize specific neighborhoods by addressing the issue of vacant houses. Public funds are distributed to private contractors who are tasked with repairing or demolishing vacant homes in targeted neighborhoods. A GIS based solution is ideal for analyzing the distribution of funds as well as the overall success of this initiative. This presentation highlights the integration of geographic information across multiple existing enterprise databases and applications maintained by various City departments. Business objects, ArcGIS Desktop, ESRI Model Builder, and existing web applications were integrated through a set of data creation and maintenance procedures and automated scripts to support an enterprise GIS web mapping application. This approach leveraged existing City resources, knowledge and roles to automate and schedule the extraction, transformation, and loading of data stored in different file formats and maintained by multiple organizations. The resulting web application provides decision makers and political leaders the ability to visualize and analyze spatial patterns associated with the properties impacted by the Home Again Initiative as well as communicate spatial information to the public.
