

OGRIP FORUM MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

I. Welcome & Introductions

- a. Welcome and introductions were conducted by Emily Whitehead, OGRIP Forum Chair.

III. Business

- a. OGRIP Initiatives (Jeff Smith)
 - i. The October OGRIP Forum Outreach Meeting, hosted by the Ohio/Michigan GIS user's group was held at ODOT District 2. It was very well attended. Leitha Sackmann was thanked for putting together the presentation which was done by Brian George of ODNR Coastal.
 - ii. LBRS – 74 Counties have delivered LBRS data and 2 more are in the process of developing data. ODOT is actively trying to get the final counties on board with the program especially since there is increased funding with help from US DOT.
 - iii. OSIP – The Statewide Imagery quality control has been completed and corrections have been returned to Woolpert. OSIP II is on schedule for a first of the year delivery. It will be distributed to 25 counties flown this spring. We are looking at 2013 for collection in Central Ohio, enhanced product prices were established through the OSIP contract. Scheduling is up to the individual county.
 - iv. Emergency Services IP Network Steering Committee held their first meeting last Monday, to provide guidance for next generation 911 implementation for the State of Ohio. OGRIP is involved to provide input on mapping requirements.

- V. **Presentation** – Joe Busemeyer, GISP, Principal GIS Programmer/Specialist with Northern Kentucky Area Planning Commission (NKAPC) presented on the Snow Tracker application which has been developed and created to be used by Kenton County Public Works during a snow event. Snow Tracker is a database for tracking road status in Kenton County. It has all road names listed that the county is responsible for plowing and treating. Each time a road is plowed or treated, it is put into the data base so residents can check and see what is happening in their area. The program also keeps track of each time anything is done on that road for future reference. It will update the road status by road name or simply by subdivision name. This website has not been in use officially yet due to lack of snow last winter.
