II. Acceptance of March 25th, 2013 Meeting Notes

- a. The March 25, 2013 OGRIP Forum Meeting Notes were motioned accepted by Jason Gillow and seconded by Ian Kidner. Motion was passed by all present.

III. Business

- a. LBRS – There is no real change since last month. OGRIP is actively negotiating with three other counties.
OSIP –The Flights were completed for the 1 ft. imagery on Friday, April 26, 2013, of twenty-two counties. Thirteen counties purchased enhanced imagery and purchased 6” or better. All enhanced products purchased will be delivered to the counties first. This will be delivered directly to the county. By December 31, 2013, we will receive the OSIP imagery from Woolpert on the 1 FT.

Vinton & Guernsey Counties have volunteered to be pilot counties for parcel projects. We are in the process of developing our requirements and standards for the State of Ohio. It is in very premature stages – nothing is in place yet. The standards are being worked on and will soon be meeting with county representatives and will try and come up with a pilot program. Data sharing agreements and transfer standards are the goal for these meetings. May 5th is the next meeting with the counties and then the next step is to contact vendors. No set date for Vendor Contact has been established.

- b. GIS User Group Updates
 - i. Ohio/Michigan – no report.
 - ii. SWOGIS - The Appalachian Ohio Geospatial Partnership along with OBGRD users group met at OSU in Piketon for a presentation and roadtrip on GPSology. It was a very good conference.
 - iii. Ohio/KI/Cincinnati – no report.
 - iv. GUONO – no report.
 - v. Central Ohio User's Group – The next meeting will be on May 7th, 2013 from 2-4 p.m. at MORPC Headquarters. They would like to discuss at this meeting how to use their funds. They will be in Boise Idaho with the FHWA Cloud Peer group meeting and discussing how government agencies are using clouds to do business. Also MORPC is having a mini conference on cloud editing and using tools for maintaining transportation. It is a best practice model.
 - vi. Appalachian Ohio Geospatial Partnership – Brett Allphin said the next meeting is on May 16th, 2013. They attended an Appalachian Council Government meeting in Greenville SC regarding NHD Stewardship and they found the session very informative.
 - vii. GIS for Strategic Asset Management – Fred let everyone know that there will be a reception in Boise and the next meeting will be May 23rd, 2013.
 - viii. OVRDC – On May 15th in Waverly the pilot project received from ODOT will be discussed. Doug Canuck with precision laser will be there.
 - ix. Buckeye Hills – Submitted their proposal seeing funding for projects. ODOT funded all five requests for projects.
- c. County Profiles - Of the 31 counties contacted for OSIP profile updates, only 3 haven't updated yet.
- d. Ohio URISA Update – Donovan Powers with ODNR said they are working on workshop ideas and topics and are looking for feedback on same. They plan on having the Chapter Representative for Logistic Communications for the conference. So far 31 abstracts have been submitted. The Abstract submission has been reopened for a short time and will close again on May 3rd. There is a preliminary program set up and they will be opening registration in June.

Presentation – Stephen Mather with Cleveland Metro Parks was unable to attend the meeting so an open forum presentation took place. Vance spoke about Franklin County's Conversion Process from Meta Map to ESRI. There was an audit on internal work flows by ESRI and all internal auditors were interviewed. They have a consultant to help with the process. The first step was to convert the process at the local government model and then at the county engineer's office. All parcel updates were done in Meta Map. They anticipate parcel conversions in a couple months. They are sticking to the local government model as much as they can.

Ian Kidner spoke about TIMS. It launched internally on April 1st, 2013 in ODOT. The week of April 22, 2013 it launched to the ODOT district offices. This training should be completed by the beginning of June. They hope to have training in LTAP later in June, July or August for anyone interested in learning more about TIMS.
