II. Acceptance of July 29, 2013 Meeting Notes

- a. Motion was made by Todd Pulsifer to accept the minutes and seconded by Darlene Magold Scott after one correction was made, which was to correct the typo in Ian Kidner's last name. All present were in favor.

III. Business

- a. LBRS – 79 counties have signed MOA with State. The latest are Clermont and Lorraine. They will go in front of the controlling board in September.
OSIP is in processing mode. The one ft. data is being processed as the enhanced products are completed and delivered. Data for 2011-12 is on OGRIP website for download. There will be more news at the OGRIP conference regarding data access and metadata. A sneak preview allows for public facing web map services. Send a url and the app can look at end points and extent of services. The perimeter for service will test outside data services.
OGRIP – Pilot for parcel development. ODOT has signed an MOA for parcel database for county. State has longer list of specifications and requirements. Vinton County has agreed to develop to standards. Will keep everyone informed as it progresses. All legacy datasets need to be converted from ODOT's database. Adjustments need to be made to event tables. LRM system will allow us to use geometry. Many systems will be replaced at ODOT.
