II. Acceptance of February 25, 2013 Meeting Notes

- a. The February 25, 2013 OGRIP Forum Meeting Notes were motioned accepted by Jason Gillow and seconded by Donovan Powers. Motion was passed by all present.

III. Business

- a. LBRS – 77 Counties have been delivered to date. Lake County’s MOA has been signed and will go to the controlling board. An MOA from Clermont County will be coming anytime. Their Commissioners will be voting on it this week.
USDOT has identified funds which can be used for Transportation for the Nation. ODOT can pay 100% towards the LBRS data collection with no requirement for matching funds. USDOT has seen significant benefits using LBRS data and MAP 21 requirements for 2014 data submission. USDOT is giving monies to local governments to support and maintain these activities.
OSIP – Vendor started collecting data on February 26th. Vendor is concentrating on 5 counties for enhanced imagery and LiDAR. The 2012 OSIP Data has been mailed out. Seven counties still have not updated their information.
Todd Tucky has come on board as a consultant to help develop parcel strategy for the state, which includes a parcel conversion program, parcel data requirements and data sharing. Todd will start tomorrow and will contact the counties to inquire how the data is gathered. It is the hope that pilot projects and ground rules for Stateside will be developed. Standards need to be developed up front and hopefully once this is developed funding will be the next step.
NG 9-1-1 - The Steering Committee has a 5-15-13 deadline as to how the NG9-1-1 project should be rolled out for the State of Ohio. Legislature will then make their evaluations, funding models, and governance models based on the recommendations from the Steering Committee on how to develop a coordinated 911 system.

 - d. Ohio URISA Update – Donovan Powers with ODNR said they are working on workshops for the Ohio GIS conference in September and membership drive renewals have been mailed. The next URISA Meeting will be on April 29th, 2013 at 1:00 p.m.

Presentation – Ian Kidner with the Planning Division of the Ohio Department of Transportation did an impromptu presentation on the TIMS (Transportation Information Mapping System) Project. It is a web-mapping application which tries to address the challenges that customers face when trying to access data, such as data is difficult to find and gather, inconsistent formats, and customers are not knowledgeable with GIS which makes it difficult for them to maneuver in programs. This will be unveiled to the ODOT Central Office by the end of May 2013. Training will be available through LTAP and support will be through the ODOT Helpdesk.
