**I. Welcome & Introductions**

**III. Business**

- a. Jeff Smith provided updates on the following OGRIP initiatives:

- i. LBRS-74 Counties are participating in the LBRS program. Belmont is currently being moved through the Controlling Board. In addition, we are having discussions with Vinton and Noble counties to participate in the program, but participation is dependent on developing a maintenance strategy that will allow them to outsource services until they are in a position to devote resources to the program.
- ii. OSIP II- Woolpert was awarded the OSIP II contract on February 8<sup>th</sup>. Woolpert will be collecting 1FT color and Infrared imagery for the state over the next 4 years. Government agencies have the opportunity to purchase enhanced imagery and elevation products off this contract through a cooperative purchase agreement with the State. Optional products include enhanced 6 inch or better imagery, 1 meter LIDAR, 5ft and 2ft contours, feature extraction using LIDAR, CIR and color imagery. In addition there are two Oblique imagery solutions that will be available through the contract using either Pictometry or SmartView. Pictometry is a licensed product, however the license agreement will make the data available to all State and local government entities. 10 counties are on board for obtaining enhanced products this Spring. Jeff indicated that any public agency that has a cooperative agreement can purchase from the State's Woolpert contract. The enhanced products can be purchased anytime off of the contract. This is not dependent on State schedule. Additional information regarding scheduling and OSIP deliverables is available through the OGRIP website.

- iii. **Outreach Meetings-Todd Tucky** reported that approximately 200 responses were received from the online survey and thanked those organizations who hosted the five outreach meetings. Approximately 100 people attended the meetings which included a good mixture of academia, township and military people. Todd is in the process of drafting a plan for delivery to the OGRIP Council for approval.
