a. Jeff Smith provided updates on the following OGRIP initiatives:

- i. OSIP II-The 2nd round officially kicked off on March 19th and began flights standard 1 FT product and 4 band single images. Eight counties are participating. Six inch image for the City of Columbus are capturing some LIDAR data. Optional oblique imagery (1) pictometry (2) Woolpert and 5 Counties signed up getting 12 inch product to neighborhood level. Ottawa is getting Woolpert solution smart view product (side by side product offering). A presentation will be held for the State, Federal and Regional then rolled out to the local levels for May 10th to outline what is available through OSIP. The 6 inch acquisition is complete and partially completed for Shelby, Lucas, Huron and Columbus for LIDAR.
- ii. OSIP I- An enhancement to DEM was completed in 2010 and took large bodies of water and river and include flatland to data is much better and cleaner and will be available in this round. Thirty meter and 10 meter is available for download.
- iii. LBRS- 6 counties are in conversation, 10 different stages of collecting data and 64 is collected and 74 counties are participating.

 - V. **Presenters: Emily Whitehead and Brad Ziss from Stantec/STARR. Title: “The Role of GIS in FEMA’s New Risk MAP program: Discovery and Beyond”**

Abstract: Beginning in Fiscal Year 2010, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) initiated the Risk Mapping, Assessment, and Planning (Risk MAP) program. The first step in the Flood Risk project lifecycle is “Discovery” of a Watershed. Currently, Ohio has three Watershed Discovery projects: Great Miami River, Little Miami River and Auglaize watersheds. This presentation will explore the importance of GIS in FEMA Risk MAP Discovery and how GIS professionals in Ohio can get involved and enhance the process. The presentation will detail how to plan for Discovery meetings, what data to bring, what to expect during the meeting, and the final results of Discovery including the various new FEMA Risk Map GIS datasets.
